(4) Can we please have the Treasurer Report.

(5) Can we please have literature report.

(6) Put a side Rent.

(7) Money's for literature.

(8) Donation to CA district.

(9) Any service commitments available (If so candidates give CV. If more than one person applies they leave room while group votes)

(10) Is everyone happy with the format of the meeting and the way it is run.

(11) Any other business.

(12) End Group conscience with serenity prayer (changing me to us & I to we)

GSR's Duties

- (1) The GSR represents the group at district on the last Sunday of every month and to take notes to bring back to group. (The GSR is the Voice of the group at district)
- (2) To Purchase literature for the group at district.
- (3) To take donations to CA treasurer at district.
- (4) To Hold group conscience before district meeting on the last Sunday of every month. (However, a group conscience can be called by any member of the group at any time)
- (5) To cover any commitment of the group if a member has not got a someone to cover their commitment
